City Hall is now open to the Public but we have a couple of things for you to note. We only have the East Door open. We ask that you wear a mask and to practice social distancing. This may mean you will need to wait outside if someone is already in the office reception area. We apologize for any inconvenience but keeping our staff and community safe is a top priority.

Did You Know...?

- There is a limit to the number of pets allowed to each resident. You can have up to 3. For example, 1 dog, 2 cats or 1 dog, 1 cat, 1 guinea pig. Chickens are not allowed in town.
- Reminder that grass clippings should not be blown into the street. This can plug city drains. You can put them in containers or bags and the DPW crew will dispose of them.
- In the fall we vacuum leaves but any other time of the year leaves need to be bagged or put in containers.
- City Park hours are from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm. The Splash Pad is open from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. The restroom at West Park is open 7:00 am to 9:00 pm. The restroom at West Park has two changing rooms with the same hours.
- For your convenience, City Hall has a drop box next to the East door for bill payments, zoning or fence permit applications and tax payments.

The City would like to thank Chief David Ellis for his service during his time here in Carson City. Dave is leaving the City's employment to pursue other life adventures. We wish him and his family the very best.
