Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Third Street into the City of Carson City was presented to Council. Motion by Pelz, seconded by Gage to approve Resolution #9-2019 and start the process to annex 433 S. Third Street. The Clinic located in Bloomer Township asked for an extension of the City sewer from Village Market. A Use Agreement II was drafted but Dr. Messenger did not response and the Agreement could not be approved by the City Council.
