Called meeting to order. Roll Call: Hauck, Kapustka, Keiffer, McCrackin, Parmenter, Tasker. Pelz excused absent.

Mayor to consider late agenda items. Mayor Tasker adding a Police Department presentation after Peerless Midwest presentation.

Minutes of the June 20, 2017 Regular Council Meeting were presented. No comments or changes. Minutes stands approved.

Council approved June 2017 bills totaling \$174,382.29. Motion by Parmenter, seconded by Keiffer.

Peerless Midwest was present to discuss the Wellhead Protection Plan. WHPP was completed in 2010. The State of Michigan is mandating the plan be updated with a contingency plan, contact personel, etc.

Police Chief Ellis presented Carson City police officer Nathan Kranich with a Life Saving Accommodation for saving a life on May 21, 2017 at 418 E. Montcalm Street in Carson City. The Heart Association also delivered a Heart Saver Hero Award for his aid in saving a life.

Request to close South Miner Street from West Elm to West Maple and West Maple Street from South Miner to South Mercantile. A whiffle ball game will be held in McKenna's field to raise money (donations) for the Park Splash Pad. The event is scheduled on July 29th unless it rains it will be July 30<sup>th</sup>. Motion by Hauck, seconded by Kapustka to approve the street closures.

Council has instructed the City Administrator Southward to continue gathering information on making changes to the financial accounts.
