AMENDMENT #8 ORDINANCE NUMBER 23

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS

TO THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OF THE

THE CITY OF CARSON CITY ORDAINS:

That Ordinance No. 23 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. AMENDED PROVISIONS.

Section 8 (Misprinted as Section VII in Amendment #4) is hereby amended as follows:

- (a). <u>ALL CUSTOMERS (metered)</u>. The rates to be charged for water services furnished by the system shall be effective for each section (North-South-Commercial) following each Quarterly reading as follows:
 - (4). The City will ensure that whatever rates are calculated that they will be sufficient to cover proper operation and maintenance of the water supply system.

Section 2. SEPARABILITY.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of the Amendment is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3. ORDINANCES REPEALED.

All ordinances, amendments and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Amendment are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The effective date of this Amendment shall be April 30, 2005, being more than ten (10) days after its enactment as provided in Section 7.3 of the City Charter.
