ORDINANCE NUMBER FORTY-FIVE

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLIES WITHIN THE CITY OF CARSON CITY, MICHIGAN.

THE CITY OF CARSON CITY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY. It is unlawful and constitues an unlawful assembly for a person to assemble or act in concert with four (4) or more persons for the purpose of engaging in conduct constituting the offense of riot, or to be present at an assemble that either has or develops such a purpose and to remain thereat with the intent to advance such purpose.

SECTION II. SEPARABILITY. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION III. ORDINANCES REPEALED. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 15 days from and after its enactment as provided by the City Charter.
