

## ORDINANCE NUMBER 50 REVISION II

### A REVISED ORDINANCE TO PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARSON CITY.

THE CITY OF CARSON CITY ORDAINS:

#### CHAPTER 50.1 AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

50.101 **AUTHORITY FOR CREATION.** Section 4.3 of the City Charter of the City of Carson City provides that compensation for the "Mayor and Councilmen shall be determined by ordinance".

50.102 **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Revised Ordinance shall be to revise the compensation for the Mayor and the City Council based upon attendance at regular and special meetings of the City Council.

#### CHAPTER 50.2 COMPENSATION

50.201 **MAYOR.** The Mayor of the City of Carson City shall be compensated at the rate of \$125.00 for each regular or special meeting he/she attends.

50.202 **CITY COUNCIL.** The City Council for the City of Carson City shall be compensated at the rate of \$85.00 for each regular or special meeting he or she attends.

50.203 **ATTENDANCE REQUIRED.** Neither the Mayor, nor the City Council shall be compensated unless they are actually in attendance at the meeting for which they are to be compensated.

50.204 **MEETING IN ATTENDANCE.** Neither the Mayor, nor the City Council shall be compensated for more than twenty four meetings per year.

50.205 **SOLE COMPENSATION.** Compensation as covered in this Chapter, unless otherwise provided for in the City Charter, shall constitute the only compensation which the Mayor and the City Council may be paid for discharge of their official duties for and on behalf of the City of Carson during their tenure of office; provided, however, that the Mayor and the City Council may upon the order of the City Council, be reimbursed for such bonafide expenses incurred in service of and on behalf of the City of Carson City as are authorized, itemized and approved pursuant to Chapter 50.3 of this Ordinance.

50.206 **METHOD OF PAYMENT.** Compensation for the Mayor and City Council shall be paid on a quarterly basis.

50.207 **REVIEW OF PAY SCALE** The City Council shall review this Chapter every two years to determine if there should be an adjustment in compensation for the Mayor and City Council.

### CHAPTER 50.3 **BONA FIDE EXPENSES**

50.301 **MILEAGE ALLOWANCE.** The Mayor and the City Council shall be reimbursed pursuant to the per mile rate set by the State of Michigan for travel incurred on behalf of the City of Carson City.

50.302 **MEAL REIMBURSEMENT.** The Mayor and the City Council shall be reimbursed for actual costs for meals while away from the City of Carson City on City business.

50.303 **PER DIEM.** When necessary the Mayor and the City Council shall be reimbursed for the actual costs of lodging incurred while on business in behalf of the City of Carson City.

50.304 **OTHER EXPENSES.** All reasonable expenses incurred on behalf of the City of Carson City by the Mayor and the City Council may be reimbursed.

50.305 **DOCUMENTATION OF EXPENSES.** No expenses shall be reimbursed unless the proper documentation is provided to the City Comptroller and such costs are itemized and approved by the City Council. In addition to the documentation, the Comptroller shall require the recipient to sign a verified expense voucher.

### CHAPTER 50.4 **APPROPRIATION**

50.401 **SOURCE.** The source of payment for compensation of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Carson City, shall be from the City Council fund.

50.402 **ANNUAL BUDGET.** Such compensation from the City Council fund, will be determined each year and shall be provided for in the annual budget of the City of Carson City.

CHAPTER 50.5  
**CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED**

On the effective date of the adoption of this Ordinance, all other conflicting ordinances, resolutions or rules regarding compensation for the Mayor and City Council are hereby repealed, rescinded and superseded by the provisions of this Revised Ordinance.

CHAPTER 50.6  
**SEVERABILITY**

If any chapter, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Revised Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

CHAPTER 50.7  
**EFFECTIVE DATE**

50.701 **EFFECTIVE DATE OF COMPENSATION.** That compensation provided for in Chapter 50.2 of this Revised Ordinance shall not, affect the Mayor and City Council during this term of office, and shall be established only for the next ensuring term of the Mayor and City Council.


50.702 **EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.** The Revised Ordinance to provide for compensation for the Mayor and City Council of the City of Carson City, shall be effective, January 1, 2002, for those individuals elected after the November 6, 2001, election, and shall be effective at the next ensuing elections for the remaining City Council Members.


CHAPTER 50.8  
**PUBLICATION**

This Revised Ordinance was published in the Carson City Gazette on January 14, 2002 pursuant to Section 7.4(b) of the Charter of the City of Carson City.
