

ORDINANCE NO. 51

## AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT EXHIBITION DRIVING.

## THE CITY OF CARSON CITY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Exhibition Driving Defined: It shall be unlawful for the driver of any motor vehicle to do exhibition driving within the City of Carson City. Exhibition driving shall be the driving of a motor vehicle in such unusual manner or out of the usual flow of traffic, whether or not traffic is present, such as to attract the attention of the public, whether or not anyone is present, and shall consist of any two or more of the following acts: (a) rapid acceleration, (b) squealing, peeling or burning of tires, (c) swaying of the motor vehicle from side to side, commonly referred to as "fishtailing", (d) racing or running of the engine of a motor vehicle at high revolutions per minute combined with the engaging of the gears, causing excessive or unusual noise, (e) unnecessary and excessive changing of lanes, and (f) the emission of any unreasonably loud or raucous or disturbing and unnecessary noise from the engine or exhaust system of any motor vehicle.

Section 2. Any person who is convicted of a violation of this ordinance is responsible for a civil infraction punishable by a civil fine of not more than \$100.00 and costs,

Section 3. SEPARABILITY. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate,

distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. ORDINANCES REPEALED. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 10 days from and after its enactment as provided by the City Charter.

ORDINANCE NO. 51

Section 2. Any person who is convicted of a violation of this ordinance is responsible for a civil infraction punishable by a civil fine of not more than \$100.00 and costs.
