AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 49 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CARSON CITY.

THE CITY OF CARSON CITY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance 49, entitles "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY ANTENNA SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF CARSON CITY, COUNTY OF MONTCALM, STATE OF MICHIGAN, TO GRANT A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO CONDOR CABLE OF MICHIGAN, FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION THEREOF" , be and hereby is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. SEPARABILITY. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independant provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3. ORDINANCES REPEALED. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 15 days from and after its enactment as as provided by the City Council.
