The City Council shall fix a date not less than 30 days after the hearing described in Section 60.703 of this Revised Ordinance for a hearing on the findings and order of the Hearing Officer and shall give notice to the owner, agent, lessee or party in interest, in the manner prescribed in Section 60.604 of this Revised Ordinance of the time and place of the hearing.	
60.802 <u>Show Cause.</u> At the hearing, the owner, agent, lessee or party in interest shall be given the opportunity to show cause why the order should not be enforced. The City Council shall either approve, disapprove, or modify the order.	
60.803 <u>Approval or Modification of Order.</u> If the City Council approves or modifies the order, the	
Council shall take all necessary action to enforce the order.
