ORDINANCE NUMBER TEN

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT BICYCLE RIDING UPON SIDEWALKS AND TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF BICYCLES UPON PUBLIC STREETS AND PENALTIES THEREFORE.

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride any bicycle upon the sidewalks along Main Street of this City at any point from the intersection of Miner and Main Streets to the intersection of First and Main Streets.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to race or speed with bicycles upon any public street of this City.

SECTION III. Any person or persons who shall be convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, for the first violation shall have impounded in the City Hall the bicycle for a period of not to exceed ten (10) days and pay in addition the costs of prosecution, and shall upon a conviction for any subsequent violation be punished by a fine not to exceed ten (10) dollars and in addition thereto the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Montcalm County for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION IV. Such ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 11th day of December, A.D. 1944.
